

## Eurex Circular 057/18

# Decommissioning of two low-frequency trading gateways in the T7 production environment

### Summary

In the fourth quarter of 2018, Eurex Exchange is planning to decommission two of the low-frequency trading gateways (L05 and L06) in the T7 production environment. Sessions currently assigned to the affected gateways will be re-assigned to the remaining gateways.

The re-assignment of the affected sessions will be performed in two steps. In the first step, on **Saturday, 13 October 2018**, the primary application gateway will be re-assigned, and in the second step, on **Saturday, 1 December 2018**, the secondary application gateway for the sessions will follow.

Following the re-assignment, Trading Participants will receive the IP addresses of the new gateways in the Connection Gateway response which will be sent out following a successful Connection Gateway request.

To provide Trading Participants with the ability to verify their technical connectivity following the changes and to facilitate a smooth migration to the newly assigned trading gateways prior to the start of production, a connection test will be provided on each of the migration weekends.

## Decommissioning of two low-frequency trading gateways in the T7 production environment

In the fourth quarter of 2018, Eurex Exchange is planning to decommission two of the low-frequency trading gateways in the T7 production environment. The following low-frequency trading gateways are affected and will no longer be available after the migration.

Gateway #	Participant Connection	IP Address
L05	Side B	193.29.91.99
L06	Side A	193.29.91.67

Sessions currently assigned to the affected gateways will be re-assigned. The re-assignment of the affected sessions will be performed in two steps on **Saturday, 13 October 2018** and on **Saturday, 1 December 2018**.

In the first step, the primary application gateway will be re-assigned, and in the second step, the secondary application gateway for the sessions will be re-assigned. The re-assignment of the sessions will be performed as follows:

Following the re-assignment of the sessions, Trading Participants will receive the IP addresses of the new gateways in the Connection Gateway response which will be sent out following a successful Connection Gateway request. Trading Participants are strongly recommended to ensure that their application currently processes the Connection Gateway response. Trading Participants can verify if their application currently processes the Connection Gateway response correctly by participating in the Focus Day “ETI Session to Gateway Re-Assignment”, offered in the T7 simulation environment. The focus day schedule is part of the simulation calendar and a description of the focus day scenario can be found in the Simulation Guide.

To provide Trading Participants with the ability to verify their technical connectivity following the changes and to facilitate a smooth migration to the newly assigned trading gateways prior to the start of production, connection tests will be provided on each of the migration weekends. The first connection test will take place in the course of the FIA Disaster Recovery Test on **13 October 2018 between 17:00 and 19:00 CET**. The second connection test will take place as part of the T7 Release 7.0 Connection Test on **1 December 2018 between 15:00 and 17:00 CET**. During this time, Customer Technical Support staff will be available. The connection test will not be mandatory, however Trading Participants with affected sessions are strongly recommended to participate. The T7 production infrastructure will also be available after the official connection test, however, no support will be provided.
